

Why Private Lessons?

Private lessons set up the child for success. With a private instructor, a child learns the fundamentals of playing. A solid foundation is built, and the child can keep learning, playing, and succeeding. Succeeding is fun! The young musician builds confidence, and

doesn't give up. A private instructor can maximize a young musician's opportunity for musical success and fun.

Why Lessons at a Studio?

Learning music is not just a matter of having a qualified teacher, but also having an environment that is focused on music education. In a professional school environment, a student cannot be distracted by TV, pets, ringing phones, siblings, or anything else. Our private music lessons are ½ hour long and given once per week. With only ½ to one hour of lesson time per week, our

environment can produce better results since the only focus at that time is learning music.

What Instrument is best?

Ultimately, the instrument you and your student choose should depend on a number of factors.

- Is your student excited about the instrument? Do they like the way it sounds and feels? We have some instruments available to try and invite you to come in and try one out.
- Is the instrument too challenging or is it not challenging enough (for both you and your student)?
- Does your student's temperament match the instrument?
- Can you afford the instrument and the maintenance that comes with it?
- As a parent, do you like the sound enough to listen to your student practice it for hours at home?
- Is your student specifically interested in a particular music style? If so, factor that into your instrument choice, as some specifically cater to certain styles.

We take new enrollments throughout the term, so it's never too late to start! We also offer private lessons during the summer in one of our two summer terms offered June 19-July 22 and July 24-Aug 19.

Lesson times are scheduled per teacher availability. Our new flute teacher is available Mon-Thur and our new drum teacher is available on Thursdays.

Music can be enjoyed for a lifetime. Try not to put unrealistic expectations on your student to progress too quickly. Everyone learns at a different pace and the key is to be able to enjoy the journey.

This summer, have your child experience the arts by enrolling in Portland Metro Arts' summer camps! Camps are one of the best opportunities for children to explore their creativity and artistic passion, in depth, that school year schedules may not allow.

PMA is unique because we offer camps focusing on dance, music, theatre, visual arts or a combination with multi-arts; unlike other programs dedicated to a single discipline with few options. We offer several week-long, all day, camps for children in grades 1-6. Camps run from 9:00am-4:00pm, Monday-Friday many camps involve a field trip or special event.

Half Day Option: If your child is unable to join us for a full-day camp, some of our camps have half-day am or pm options.

Childcare for Full-Day campers is available starting as early as 8:00am and going as late as 6:00pm, at no additional charge. Half-day AM campers may make use of before camp childcare and half-day PM campers may make arrangements to remain after camp until 6:00pm.
